## County made right decision on building permits

Of all the decisions the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors have made over the years, suspending building permits - all building permits - in the vicinity of military installations in the county was perhaps the least defensible. All because of a lawsuit brought against the county by Attorney General Terry Goddard, whose basis for the entire action was to prohibit the county from

issuing residential housing building permits in high-risk potential areas.
